Go Boldly Results

Our *Go Boldly* pledge total as of December 2010 is \$11.8 million, a total that will only grow larger as we continue to receive pledges. That is a great number to celebrate for several reasons.

First, it represents pledges received from over 1,200 individuals, with 319 of those pledges coming from leader households. This reflects the high level of enthusiasm and commitment we have as a church family for living fully into the mission God has given us.

Second, while we did have a few large pledges – and we are certainly thankful for them – most of the commitments came from people with more modest budgets who gave boldly and sacrificially.

We have many generous faith gifts, from many people. I'll never forget our Bold Step weekend, seeing so many come up to the stage to make their pledges.

The third reason to celebrate this number is that it is short of our goal of \$16 million. Yes, you read that right. In a strange way, not achieving the entire goal may be a blessing. While we didn't reach our target, our pledge total is still a great number.

It is right on that “go/no go” line to enable us to move forward with the core elements of the project. We won't be able to do everything we had planned, but here is a cause for celebration: if we had raised the total goal amount, we might have been in danger of viewing these next few years as virtually “faith free.” Raising something

less than our goal now means that we are going to be experiencing some faith-stretching years on our journey.

As Agur prayed in Proverbs 30:

Give me neither poverty nor riches, but give me only my daily bread.

Otherwise, I may have too much and disown you and say, “Who is the LORD?”

Or I may become poor and steal, and so dishonor the name of my God.

God has given us just enough to move forward, but it means every step will be a prayerful one requiring our dependence on Him.
